Introduction

The International Society of Behavioral Nutrition and Physical Activity (ISBNPA) will host its 16th Meeting in Victoria BC, one of Canada's most historic and enchanting cities. The meeting will be held in the Victoria Conference Centre (VCC), a first class purpose built conference centre situated in the heart of the city centre on the harbor and attached to the world famous Empress hotel.

The mission of ISBNPA is to "stimulate, promote and advocate innovative research and policy in the area of behavioral nutrition and physical activity toward the betterment of human health worldwide".

The scientific programme will consist of keynote plenary lectures from world leading researchers. Parallel sessions of symposia, short orals and workshops will provide key updates and debate on recent progress in theory, methods and new findings related to physical activity and nutrition behaviour. Scientific poster sessions will also be key sessions of scientific exchange both informally during coffee breaks and lunchtimes.
